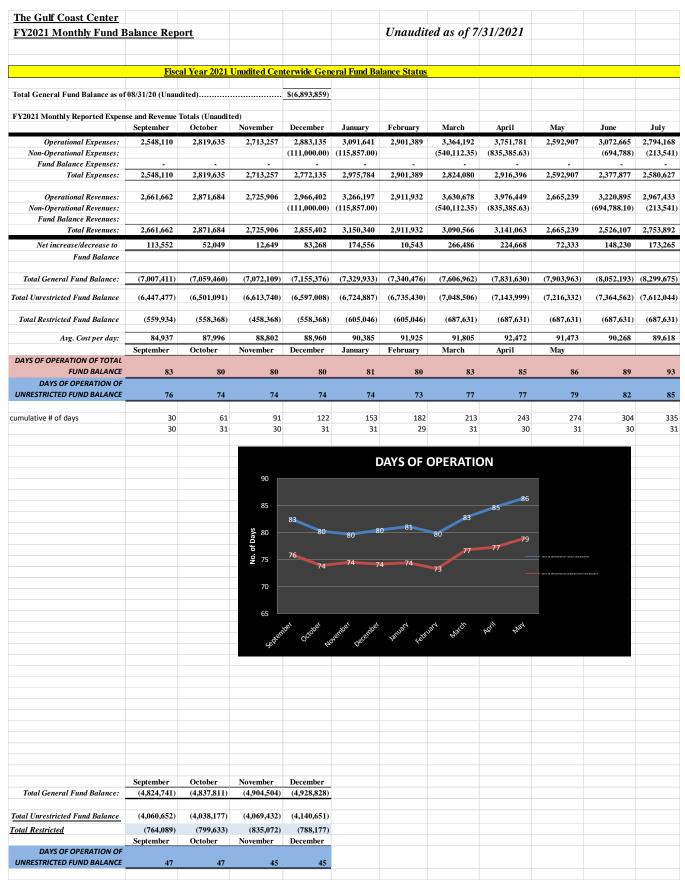

3. Program Report: Todd Patch and Erin Roman of Marsh & McLennan Agency provided a presentation for FY22 renewal of the Employee Health Benefit Plan Coverage, reviewing last month's presentations and then detailing the final decisions to change employee healthcare coverage from Aetna to Blue Cross/Blue Shield (BCBS) and to join the MHDD Captive stoploss coverage plan. The decision was primarily a result of UTMB no longer being within the Aetna network, over 50% of employees utilizing a UTMB provider over the last year, and the vast network coverage provided by BCBS. No increase in healthcare payment cost to employees occurred in FY21 due to waiving this year, due to the stress impact of Covid on all staff. GCC is now on track with the plan approved several years ago to increase employee associated cost in reasonable amounts each year, for several years. Providing plan options and increasing employee cost should bring a 1.6% increase over budget- or about \$50,000 increase in FY22.

- 5. Operations Report: Melissa Meadows, CEO
 - a. CCBHC Application Update: Melissa Meadows, CEO, reported that frontline leadership and frontline staff completed formal interviews with Health and Human Services on July 6 and 9, 2021, respectively. Meadows noted that the formation of CCBHC Academy, early identification of key staff, and utilization of mock interviews drove the positive feedback received from staff. Meadows reported that Gulf Coast Center submitted additional information for CCBHC Submission on July 9, 2021 and is awaiting final score.

- 6. Budget, Finance and Admin ReportsRick Elizondo, CFO
 - a. Financial & Operational Monthly Report & YTD Summary: Rick Elizondo, CFO, reported a surplus of \$148,000 for the month of June 2021, with the expectation of a continued trend July through August 2021, with a projected 1.3-to-1.4-million-dollar surplus for the year. Elizondo explained that would bring GCC to a little over 8 million dollars YTD in Total Fund Balance, with 82 days of unrestricted operation. Health Insurance Income Statement reflects higher claims than in previous years, totaling YTD at (-) \$437,000. Having received checks from re-insurers for \$320,000, that leaves GCC with around (-) \$100,000 deficit. Elizondo detailed the findings of the Quarterly Report, with Total Cash Available at \$7 million dollars, and with \$5,000 in earnings. Elizondo concluded a positive cash flow overall for FY21 and is therefore, setting an intention to look for investments with greater returns in FY22.
